Mail reviewed.

Discussed status of Shelburne boundary. Awaiting new survey information from Shelburne.

Discussed convenience store issues. Heard from local residents Teresa Grenda and Royal Palin re late night/early am deliveries and expanded hours of operation. Tom will ask Ed Hanson to contact Joe Handy regarding delivery schedule, signage directing egressing traffic to outbound lane of Town Center entrance, and hours of operation.

Discussed getting town office basement remedy. Philip to get quotes from contractors.

Continued work on budget. Caroline presented case for summer camp program and request for \$10,000 in budget based on 2007 costs and lack of school budget contribution in upcoming year. Marley presented case for increase in cemetery budget for survey of existing plots and investigation of expansion potential.

Discussed clean up and tree work at school house that Lori and Wayne Ring eager to do. Grant funds apparently cannot be used for tree work. Decided to leave tree as is, as town yet to decide future of building and tree appears to be stable.

Tom reported State working with owner of Chambers Mobile Home Park re short term and longer term remedies.

Tom reported on interest in Town Center lots 4 and 5 has apparently come and gone.

Tabled permit fee schedule review.

Barbara reported she is looking into means and cost of preserving land records on microfiche.

Discussed annual Selectboard expense payments and efforts of DRB/PC this year. Resolved to share board payments equally across boards.
