

MINUTES OF  
ST. GEORGE SELECTBOARD MEETING  
OCTOBER 16, 2008

Present: Tom Carlson, Bob Gugerty, Phil Gingrow, Barbara Young, Lou Drudi

Minutes of September meeting approved.

Orders approved.

Reviewed bids for emergency Ayer Road work and awarded to Pillsbury Excavating as low bidder at \$22,000. Work required by ultimatums from Post Office, Williston school buses and Williston Public Works.

Discussed town office foundation work and unavoidable expenditure of additional \$10,000 for new poured walls in most of north portion of building.

Resolved to proceed with Ayer Road work and to pay for foundation cost overrun from general fund until cash flow requires use of town land sales proceeds now held in CD, and then to ask town meeting whether to permanently apply town land proceeds or raise the funds by 2008-09 tax collections.

Lou Drudi present to object to letter from town advising plowing would stop at Pinkhams since he invested in moving a telephone pole and widening his driveway to allow Williston trucks to turn around. Board resolved to address issue with Neil Boyden.

Schoolhouse project moving ahead slowly, awaiting formation of non-profit.

Shelburne boundary arbitration moving like molasses.

Bob willing to prepare dog bite protocol based on recent experience to minimize future uncertainty.

Worked on 08-09 budget. Decided to include \$100 to Women Helping Battered Women. Board would like presentation from summer camp organizers regarding increased request. Line items reviewed and adjusted. Plan is to finalize budget at November meeting.

Reviewed complaints about noise and other activity at basketball court. Resolved to look into contract with Hinesburg Police or sheriff to patrol closing hours.
