Bob asked if a culvert inventory was available, and Charlie was able to have Pam Brangan of CCRPC GIS Services provide them to us the next day by email. Pam's email also noted: "We are also planning to hire interns to provide culvert and/or sign inventories this summer. If St. George has an interest in having culverts or signs inventoried, please let me know."
